- Discussion of the process being used by the planner, with the advisory committee being just one part. Bill Weber is also gathering data, there will be the community opinion survey, and Town Forums.
- Bill Weber presented a document outlining three general Land Use Alternatives. The three alternatives are Agricultural Land Use, Agriculture and Housing, and Semi-Rural Housing. Within each of these theoretical alternatives, there are sections for Theme of the Alternative, Principal Features, Major Assumptions, Time Frame, Agriculture, Housing, Business or Industry, Sewer and Water Services, Roads, Uses Requiring Rural Locations, Home Occupations, Natural Resources, and Post-2030 Plan. Each section was discussed within each of the three alternatives.
- We will have two additional meetings before the Town Forum scheduled on January 23. Meetings will be held on December 12 and January 9.
- Next Meeting: Tuesday, December 12. Agenda is to continue discussing and refining the Land Use Alternatives outlined above and begin to formulate a plan that is a hybrid of these alternatives.
