**Re:** Envisioning Task Force Progress Report

As I explained at last week's board meeting, I am unable to attend tonight's continued meeting because we have an Envisioning Task Force meeting scheduled. However, this memo provides a current update on our progress.

Since the Annual Meeting, the Envisioning Task Force has met three times. Despite some setbacks during the last few months, we are making steady progress on our work, which is currently devoted to completing a written report of the 1000 Friends/Dakota County CommunityViz study.

At the Annual Meeting, we estimated the report would be completed by May. Unfortunately, this work has taken longer than anticipated. As the accompanying table of contents for the report shows, we are finished with approximately half of the report at this point. If we continue at the current pace, I estimate that we will have the report completed no later than the August town board meeting and—barring any unforeseen problems—probably sooner.

Although we have set no dates at this point, once the report is completed, we still hope to hold one or two additional public open houses to share our work with interested township residents.

If you have additional questions or concerns, I would be happy to address them at the June board meeting.
