

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 11 AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN STANDARDS FOR EASEMENTS FOR UTILITIES AND OTHER SERVICES IN SUBDIVISIONS

The Town Board of the Township of Eureka, County of Dakota, State of Minnesota, ordains as follows:

Ordinance No. 11 regulating the subdivision and platting of land in the Town of Eureka is amended to provide an additional subsection to Section 3 of said Ordinance as follows:

- G. Dakota County Model Subdivision Ordinance, adopted January 20, 1972, Section D (1), shall read as follows:

Provided for Utilities. At the rear of each lot, there shall be provided an easement at least fifteen (15) feet in width for the installation of sanitary sewer, water and other such services whenever such services may be provided by the governing body. At the front of each lot, there shall be established an easement at least six (6) feet in width for the installation of underground utilities. There shall be continuity of alignment of the easements herein provided for from block to block.
