

ORDINANCE NO.19

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SWIMMING POOLS

The Town Board of the Township of Eureka, Dakota County, Minnesota, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS

A swimming pool is any structure above or below ground that contains over 15,000 gallons of water and is over 2 feet deep at its maximum depth.

SECTION 2. CONSTRUCTION

Permits will be required at a cost of \$25.00 and will be issued by the Clerk, and inspection will be by the Township Building Inspector.

SECTION 3. FENCING

All pools must be fenced to a height of 4 1/2 feet, with a fence that will not allow any object more than 4 inches square to penetrate.

SECTION 4. GATES

All pools must have self-closing gates that open away from the pool.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATES

This Ordinance applies only to swimming pools constructed after effective dates, which will be immediately after publication in a legal newspaper.
