

**ORDINANCE NO. 2**

**AN ORDINANCE REGLATING TO THE LICENSING OF  
DOG KENNELS WITHIN THE TOWN OF EUREKA**

The Town Board of the Town of Eureka does hereby ordain:

**Section 1 - DEFINITIONS**

- 1.1 A dog kennel is a place where six or more dogs over six months of age are kept or harbored, or any place in which the business of selling, boarding, breeding, showing or treating of dogs is conducted, when there are six or more dogs involved.

**Section 2 - LICENSES REQUIRED**

- 2.1 From and after January 1, 1967 no dog kennel as herein defined shall be operated or maintained within the Town of Eureka, unless the operator thereof shall first have applied for and obtained a kennel operators license. Such license shall be issued for one year beginning with the year 1967. The operator of a dog kennel shall pay an annual license fee of one-hundred-dollars (\$100.00) to the Town of Eureka. No dog kennel, other than one in operation at the time of the passage of this ordinance, shall be established within 500 feet of any dwelling house, other than the dwelling occupied by the operator of the kennel, unless both the owner and lessee of said adjoining dwelling house consent in advance in writing to the establishment of said kennel.

**Section 3 - MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- 3.1 Any dog kennel licensed hereunder shall be kept and maintained at all times in a clean and sanitary condition, and dogs kept therein shall be reasonably restrained from annoying the neighborhood or general public by loud, frequent or habitual barking, yelping or howling.

**Section 4 - VIOLATION**

- 4.1 Any violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor.

**Section 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE**

- 5.1 This Ordinance shall take effect and force from and after its passage and publication.
