### PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING OF APRIL 2, 2019

### I. Call to Order

The Eureka Township Planning Commission meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by Chair Ralph Fredlund.

### II. Approval of the Agenda

The following changes were requested to be made to the agenda:

- 1. Ralph Fredlund: Add under Citizen Inquiry, item A. Beth Voelker building right inquiry.
- 2. Ralph Fredlund: Add under Citizen Inquiry, item B. Victor Volkert lot split question.
- 3. Julie Larson: Add under New Business, item A. Discussion regarding redacting check information before copying.

**Motion**: Vice Chair Funk moved to approve the agenda as amended, seconded by Commissioner Larson. **Motion carried 5-0** 

### III. Citizen Inquiry

A. Beth Voelker – Building right inquiry for 7987 257th St.

Ms. Voelker asked for confirmation of building rights for the parcel, stating that the Gardenview greenhouse is out of business and the residence on the property, which was for housing workers, is no longer occupied or used. Chair Fredlund stated that the property tax records show the residence as a 1 bedroom, 1½ bath built in 1969 and in his opinion, it would not be eligible for another building right. Ms. Voelker stated that it only has a half bath and is no longer used as an apartment. Supervisor Hansen added that the building would not have to be torn down, but it cannot be used as living quarters. The Planning Commission asked the Clerk to have the building inspector assess the building prior to the Town Board meeting. If the Certificate of Occupancy was revoked, it would no longer be a dwelling.

**Motion:** Chair Fredlund moved to forward to the Town Board for determination and certification, seconded by Commissioner Novacek. **Motion carried 5-0** 

B. <u>Dan Fredrickson and representative Victor Volkert</u>– Lot Split inquiry for 3 parcels: PID# 13-03400-78-001, PID# 13-03500-53-011 and PID# 13-03500-52-010. Mr. Fredrickson would like to approve two splits from parcel 1 with no changes to parcels 2 & 3. See attached documents.

The Planning Commission requested that they apply for the lot split using Eureka Township's forms and submit them at the May 7, 2019 Planning Commission meeting.

**Motion:** Commissioner Larson moved to forward the application for Don & Cindy Oreskovich for an inground pool, PID# 13-02100-51-011, to the Town Board recommending approval, seconded by Commissioner Wood. **Motion carried 5-0** 

D. <u>Tyler Schrupp</u> – 24187 Highview Ave, PID# 13-24660-00-061 – Pole shed The commissioners reviewed the application submitted for a pole shed.
