# **A Letter from Dakota County Transportation Department**

Dakota County is planning to construct turn lanes and bypass lanes at various locations along County Road (CR) 23 (Cedar Ave./Galaxie Ave.) between CR 86 and 240<sup>th</sup> Street in Eureka Township. The purpose of this project is to improve traffic safety and operations. The project is scheduled for construction in 2022.

Improvements are proposed at the following intersections:

- CR 23/CR 86 (right turn lane)
- CR 23/265<sup>th</sup> St. (bypass lane)
- CR 23/CR 80 (right turn lane and bypass lane)
- CR 23/247<sup>th</sup> St. (bypass lane)
- CR 23/240th St. (bypass lane)

Dakota County does not anticipate any closures of CR 23 during construction. Short-term closures of side streets and accesses along CR 23 are possible.

Construction will be performed on County property. No acquisition of property from adjacent landowners is anticipated. Turn lanes and bypass lanes will be constructed at the same elevation as the existing road. Because turn lanes and bypass lanes involve widening of the pavement, some change to the grades of existing accesses (driveways, field entrances, etc.) are anticipated.

## **Road Committee**


Seven Eureka citizens found a way to be involved in the community by being part of the Road Committee.




### Important Reminder!

In Minnesota, "It is illegal and punishable as a misdemeanor to plow, shovel, blow or place snow onto [roadways]."

That includes any federal, state, county, municipal or township roads. Penalties can be increased if illegal snow removal results in accidents or injuries.

When plowing snow from your property, it must be stored on your own property.

Mr. M. A. Halling, Registrar, Eureka Tp., Dakota County, Farmington, Minnesota.

My dear Sir:

We have your letter of November 7th in which you refer to the unreported birth which you state occurred in the family of Martin Larson on August 28th, 1931. Doctor Sanford is an old offender in the matter of failing to report births which he attends. At various times complaints have been filed against him by our Vital Statistics Agent and he has been compelled to pay a fine. His attention has repeatedly been drawn by this Department to the fact that the law requires physicians to report births within ten days. We are writing the doctor again today as per enclosed copy. We cannot be certain from your letter that the mother was confined at home in Eureka Township. This, however, you may be able to learn by telephoning the family if you can call them up without charge.

With your letter you send in "no report" cards for June and October. I am sorry the June card did not come in on time so that we might have allowed you the regular fee for it. Attention is called to the enclosed copy of Sections 20 and 21 of your Manual of Instructions.

### Are you Naughty or Nice?

Each month Eureka Township receives a list from Dakota County revealing which properties are not in compliance with their septic tanks. According to Minnesota Pollution Control Agency Rules, septic tanks need be pumped or serviced at least once every three years. The Township did send out a reminder letter to those on the "naughty" list. Please make sure your ISTS system is assessed and/or pumped to bring it into compliance with Minnesota SSTS Code 7080. Septic pumpers are required to submit monthly pump logs to Dakota County and records are updated accordingly.
