

Eureka Town Board Special Meeting  
February 27, 2001

An emergency meeting of the town board was called on February 27. The roads on the east side of the township were not adequately cleared from the February 24 - 25 snowfall and several members of the board had received complaint calls. Buses had been in the ditch, parents struggled with the roads to get kids to school, and Denmark Ave was reported to have a single plowed lane 48 hours after the snowfall had quit. Don Pflaum made a motion to relieve Mr. Gilmer of snow removal responsibilities on the east side, immediately, rather than wait until March 12 and to have him continue sanding and doing general maintenance until March 12, seconded by Supervisor Topp and carried. Clark Smith was asked to inform Gilmer of this decision. The meeting was adjourned.
