A number of actions were discussed. These included:

Spot gravel as required (within budget)

Brush cutting (throughout Township)

Replace signs and add delineators as required

255th Street and Old Cedar, Caution Sign, No Outlet.

257th Street at Highview Ave. Trees on north side need to be removed to provide visibility for intersection.

Grenada, repair frost boils and spot gravel.

Jamaica, tree trimming.

Iberia, replace damaged culvert (approximately 275th).

Ipava Ave., 3-inch lift (compacted), lime rock.

250th Street West of Dodd, touch up and chloride end to end.

257th Street, gravel.

245th Street, limerock as needed, place delineators where road narrows.

240th Street, Dodd to Highview, 3-inch lift (compacted) lime rock.

Holyoke Path (Eureka Estates), get bid for blacktop overlay.

225th Street at Highview Ave., restore ditch.

225th Street at Highview Ave., raise stop sign.

235th Street and Dodd Blvd., place stop sign at work access to 235th.

240th Street and Hamburg Ave. Remove or trim trees blocking view on northwest corner. Agenda item.

220th Street, contact Farmington, their year for maintenance.

Fairgreen Ave., approximately 273rd, culvert delineators.

Denmark Ave., approximately 270th, culvert delineators.
