The abandoned vehicle ordinance of the county was hashed over. Clerk was to write a letter asking for definition of abandoned vehicle, also in regard to residential and farm areas.

Motion by Wacther, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Swedin to delete hardship clause from mobile home ordinance.

Board voted to panel walls of the town hall.

Carl Rother was present and was instructed to put up stop signs at 225<sup>th</sup> St and Highview.

Bills were ordered paid.

Culvert and installation on Iberia were ordered paid out of Revenue sharing.
