

Eureka Township
Board Meeting
October 14, 1985

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P. M. by chairman Kadlec. Also present were supervisors Schindledecker, Curry and Lee; as were clerk Leine and treasurer Shaff.

Leine read the minutes of the previous meeting. Schindledecker made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Motion seconded by Curry and carried with no dissenting votes.

Shaff gave the treasurer's report. Curry made a motion to accept the report as presented. Motion seconded by Lee and carried unanimous.

Bills totalling \$7806.67 were presented by Leine. Additional bills presented were \$1986.00 from Cannon Watershed Management and \$1106.00 from Vermillion Watershed Management groups. After discussion Curry made a motion to pay all bills excluding the two watershed management groups. Motion seconded by Schindledecker and carried with no dissenting votes.

Bruce Jorgenson, 220th Street, requested a permit to build a 50 by 80 foot addition to his facility on Airlake Airport. This property is not part of the new hanger plotting at Airlake. His request was for a renewal of a permit previously granted. The board advised the previous permit was expired and too old for renewal. The plans submitted showed new building would not satisfy side lot line set back requirement. Jorgenson stated he had discussed trading a parcel on one side of his property for one on the other and with that acquisition the side lot set back would no longer be a problem. Curry made a motion the permit be granted when Jorgenson presented Leine with proof of land trade. At presentation of that proof permit would be presented. Motion seconded by Lee and carried with no dissenting votes.
