There was a discussion on improving a road to Chub lake. Motion made to spend up to \$300.00 on this road to Chub Lake if the state would go along with the opinion the Corp. Motion carried.

Motion made to hold the business meeting at 1:30 P.M. on election day in 1959. Motion carried.

Motion made to hold the polls open from 1:30 P.M. to 8:00 P.M.

The Committee on Civil Defense submitted a set of rules on what to do and not to do in case of a bombing attack. After discussion a motion was made to spend up to \$200.00 for giger counters.

Motion amended to include buying 2 protector suits. Amendment and motion both carried.

Motion to adjourn.

Motion carried.
