

1981 Town Meeting  
March 10, 1981

The town meeting of Eureka Township was held at the town hall.

The polls were closed at 8:00 pm and Cheryl Schindeldecker, Robert ladduasaw and Ollie Leine were appointed as tellers.

The clerk called the meeting to order and Henry Larson was elected moderator.

The clerk report of the 1980 meeting was accepted as read.

The treasurer gave a report on part of the finances including the Castler Rock Community Fund.

The clerk then gave a report on the financial poster's he had prepared.

Gary Smith then presented the proposed budget for 1982. After discussion on the amount needed \$85,000.00 was approved for general revenue.

Dust control was then talked over and as it was already on the budget the matter was left to the board.

The Senior Citizen Center at Farmington having sent a representative to our February meeting asking for a donation of \$750.00 which the board approved pending a decision of the annual meeting. Their action was approved on a motion by Wayne Doyle seconded by Mary Ann Sly.

Time of board meeting was changed to 7:30 on a motion by Gary Gunderson seconded by Cheryl Schindeldecker.

Next discussion of board pay per meeting. Presently \$15.00 per meet; raised to \$20.00 on a motion by Lee Topp, seconded by Doyle.

Marris Johnson asked about law enforcement. Board was instructed to ask for faster response.

Dog problems were discussed and Doyle pointed out we have an ordinance that take care of this problem.
