

Annual Town Meeting
March 8, 1966

The annual Town meeting, held in the Town of Eureka in the County of Dakota and State of Minnesota, at Eureka Town Hall on the 8th day of March, 1966 was called to order by the clerk and Robert Alexandra was then chosen to preside as moderator at the meeting.

Clerk report read and accepted as read.

Treasurer report read and on a motion was accepted as read.

On motion, it was ordered, that the following sums of money be raised by tax upon the taxable property in said town for the purposes of current year:
Town Fund Motion by Henry Larson Seconded by Hinkle Mallery for \$2,000.00. Motion carried.

R.B. Fund motion by Charles Hallcock Seconded by Glen Shirley for \$10,000. Motion carried.

Ordinance on zoning was read by the clerk a very good discussion followed.

Discussion on mowing the roadsides versus spraying the roadside followed.

The board was asked to explore the possibility of spraying as it might be better and cheaper. No motion taken.

Mr. Lawrence Fredrickson requested that the board allow him to have a junk yard on his farm. No motion taken. It was left to the Town Board to iron out this matter.

Motion to adjourn. Motion carried.
