

Eureka Township Minutes March 9, 1998

The Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Schindledecker. Present were Supervisors Kadlec, Smith and Topp, Clerk Leine and Treasurer Schulz.

Supervisor Topp moved to accept the February 9, 1998 minutes as read, seconded by Supervisor Kadlec and carried.

Supervisor Kadlec moved to accept the treasure's report as read, seconded by Supervisor Smith and carried.

Clerk Leine presented the board with bills totalling \$3,828.96. Supervisor Smith moved to pay these bills, seconded by Supervisor Kadlec and carried. The Farmington Fire bill for 1997 was deferred to the April board meeting.

Karen Ostlie, 9631 - 267th St., requested a permit for a 42 x 90 pole frame building. Plot plan and setbacks were shown. Supervisor Topp moved to grant permit, seconded by Supervisor Smith and carried.

Mr. Sauber, representing Mary Sauber, has asked for a land split in Section 5. See attached for Legal. Applicants were informed that these sites being created by this land split are not buildable lots without clustering, and Parcel " B" has no public road frontage therefor it is not a legal lot for building. Supervisor Smith moved to grant this split contingent upon a signed letter of request for split by the landowner (Mrs. Mary Sauber), seconded by Supervisor Topp and carried.

Supervisor Topp moved to present the 1999 budget as worked out by the board, seconded by Supervisor Smith and carried.

Supervisor Topp moved to appoint Gene Kaufenberg, Cheryl Schindledecker, and Gladys Turnquist as election judges for the annual election in Eureka Township, seconded by Supervisor Smith and carried.

Supervisor Topp moved to adjourn, seconded by Supervisor Kadlec and carried.

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
