KADLEC MOVED TO PAY THE BILLS PRESENTED BY CLERK LEINE, SECONDED BY SMITH AND CARRIED.

NO LETTER HAS ARRIVED AT THE TOWNSHIP FROM MIKE RUTTEN DETAIL1NG THE BIES COMPLAINT OF SEPTIC VIOLATIONS. SMITH TO FOLLOW-UP WITH RUTTEN AS TO WHERE LETTER IS. UNCONFIRMED REPORT FROM A PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBER INFORMS THAT THE NEIGHBOR TO THE WEST OF BIES MAY HAVE INSTALLED A NEW SEPTIC SYSTEM. IF SO, THERE HAS BEEN NO NEW PERMIT ISSUED FOR THIS SEPTIC SYSTEM.

SMITH MOVED TO INTER INTO THE AWAIR PROGRAM AND ACCEPT THE MISSION STATEMENT ATTACHED, SECONDED BY KADLEC AND CARRIED.
