



Dakota County is hosting a recycling event for rural residents. All households located in Dakota County townships or rural cities are invited to attend. Please note the following:

Date: Saturday, June 24

Time: 9:00 a.m. – Noon

Where: Dakota County Maintenance Facility, 2800 160th St. W, Rosemount

Only these four (4) types of items will be accepted:

- Mattresses and Box Springs – \$30.00 for each item
 - Keep dry, no bed bugs
 - Cash or check preferred, Make checks payable to “Certified Recycling”
 - *A \$10 off coupon will be mailed to each rural household in June*

- Passenger Vehicle Tires – Free
 - Tires must be off rims
 - Tires must be less than 30” in diameter
 - Maximum of six (6) tires per household

- Cardboard – Free
 - Flatten cardboard boxes
 - No wax-lined boxes

- Confidential documents for shredding – Free
 - Confidential materials such as papers with account numbers or other private information will be shredded on-site.
 - Maximum four (4) boxes or paper bags per household
 - Remove three-ring binders and metal file tabs
 - Bring already-shredded paper to The Recycling Zone in Eagan
 - Put non-confidential papers in your home recycling cart
