DRIVEWAY OR APPROACH PERMIT INSTRUCTIONS

The following is a summary of the Driveway and Field Approach requirements. It is the responsibility of the applicant to read the complete cited Ordinances noted below.

DRIVEWAY

A road giving access from a Township Road, private road or cartway to one or more dwelling units or agricultural buildings located or to be constructed on adjacent lands.


FIELD APPROACH

An access route from a public road to an adjacent field or pasture.

Note: If your Driveway or Field Approach enter onto a county road you will need to contact Dakota County for a permit application.

General Requirements check list:

- ☐ Complete Driveway / Approach Permit Application (See Attached)
- ☐ Pay Application fee Ordinance § 126.2 (D)
 - > Driveway or approach permit: \$100.
- ☐ Provide Proof of ownership:
 - > Parcel ID Ordinance § 240.9A will be verified by the Town Clerk; conflicts must be resolved with a proper deed.
- ☐ County permit or letter of exemption if located in the Dakota County Shoreland Zoning
- ☐ Provide one (1) copy of the following:
 - > Sample Site Plan Illustration

The parcel on which a dwelling unit is located shall have at least **33 feet** of frontage along a public road. Landlocked lots may meet access requirements as specified in **Ordinances § 240-13 and § 198-3**.

Culverts are the responsibility of the applicant. Size and placement must be approved by the Town Board designated Road Supervisor before a permit is issued. **Ordinance 198-12 B**
